

Launched in 2017, the Egypt Petroleum Show is North Africa and the Mediterranean's most important oil and gas exhibition and conference held under the patronage of His Excellency Abdel Fattah El Sisi, President of the Arab Republic of Egypt where oil and gas professionals convene to engage in dialogue, create partnerships, do business and identify solutions and strategies that will shape the industry for future years.

WHY EGYPT?



Egypt signed 51 agreements with international oil companies (IOCs), which will attract \$27.2 billion to the oil and gas sector in the coming period



New phases of four mega-projects in the Mediterranean Sea – Zohr, North Alexandria, Nooros and Atoll fields, will take maximum production rates to 6.5 bcf/d



Egypt exported petroleum products for \$3.1 billion within 2018



Egypt achieved self-sufficiency of locally produced natural gas at the end of September 2018, and in turn halted liquefied natural gas (LNG) imports for the first time in more than 3 years




Egypt made 61 new oil and gas discoveries in 2018, of which were 43 crude oil discoveries and 18 were natural gas discoveries






PURCHASING AUTHORITY OF VISITORS*


BREAKDOWN OF VISITORS PURCHASING AUTHORITY BY VALUE




